



Bikeability Training Parent/Carer Consent Registration Information

Dear Parent / Carer,

We are delighted to share that Bethany school has signed up for free Bikeability Cycle training provided by BCP Council.

Bikeability has replaced Cycling Proficiency as the government's national cycle training programme. It is funded by the Department for Transport and is delivered by trained, DBS-checked Bikeability instructors.

Bikeability trains riders to make independent decisions and practice safe and responsible cycling. It is offered at different levels to support your child's increasing skills and confidence. Riders must demonstrate all assessment criteria for each level independently before they progress on to the next Bikeability level. Your child's instructor will work with the school to advise you when your child is ready for the next level. These levels are: -

- **Learn to Ride** – develops basic skills in riding a pedal bike without stabilisers.
- **Playground Bike Skills (Level 1)** - develops cycle handling skills before riding on the road.
- **Residential Road Training (Level 2)** develops skills for cycling on single-lane roads with simple junctions and moderate traffic.
- **Advanced Cycle Training (Level 3)** – aimed at Year 7 and above, develops skills for cycling on busy, complex roads and junctions.

If your child has been registered as a new rider, they will initially join a 1-hour Learn-to-Ride session in the school main playground. If they are then able to ride independently, they will be invited to join a subsequent 1.5-hour Level 1 session on a different date, again in the main playground.

If your child already rides independently, they will join a 1.5-hour Level 1 session in the main playground.

We hope all riders will then be able to join a 2-hour Level 2 session riding on quiet residential roads which we hope to offer in the next academic year.

Please check that your child's bike and helmet are in full working condition and bring them in on the chosen date(s).
