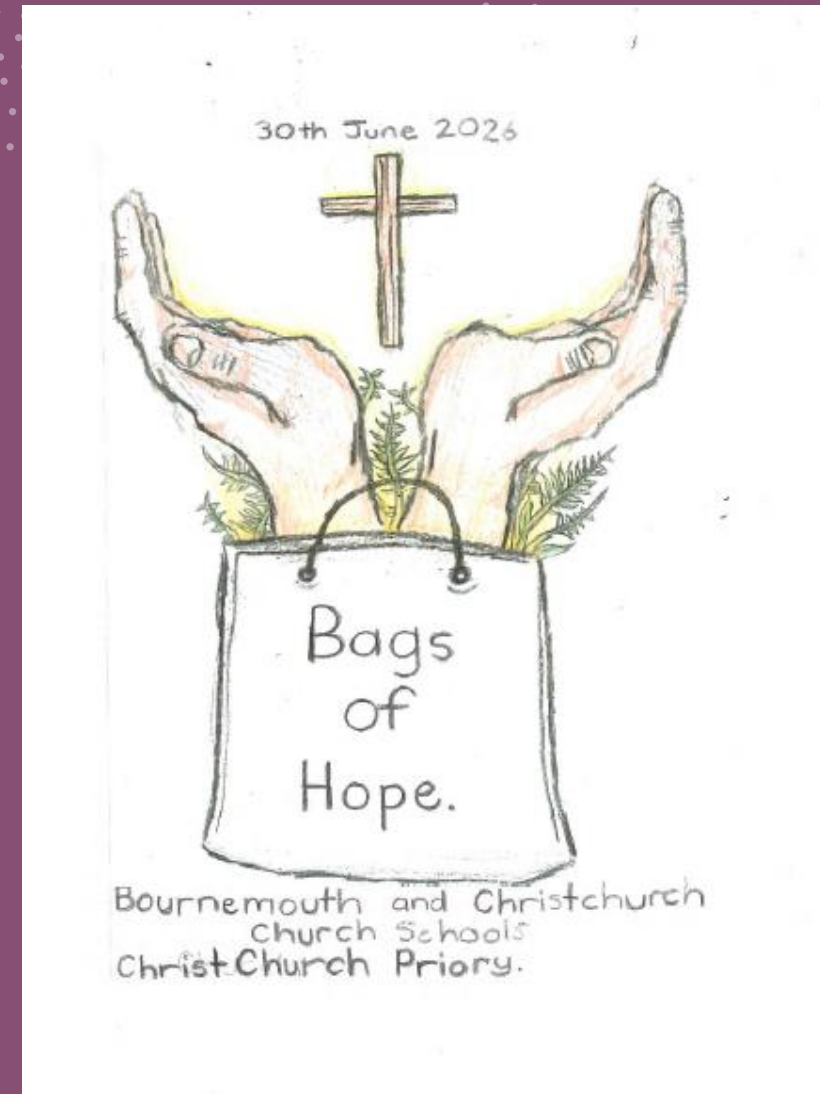

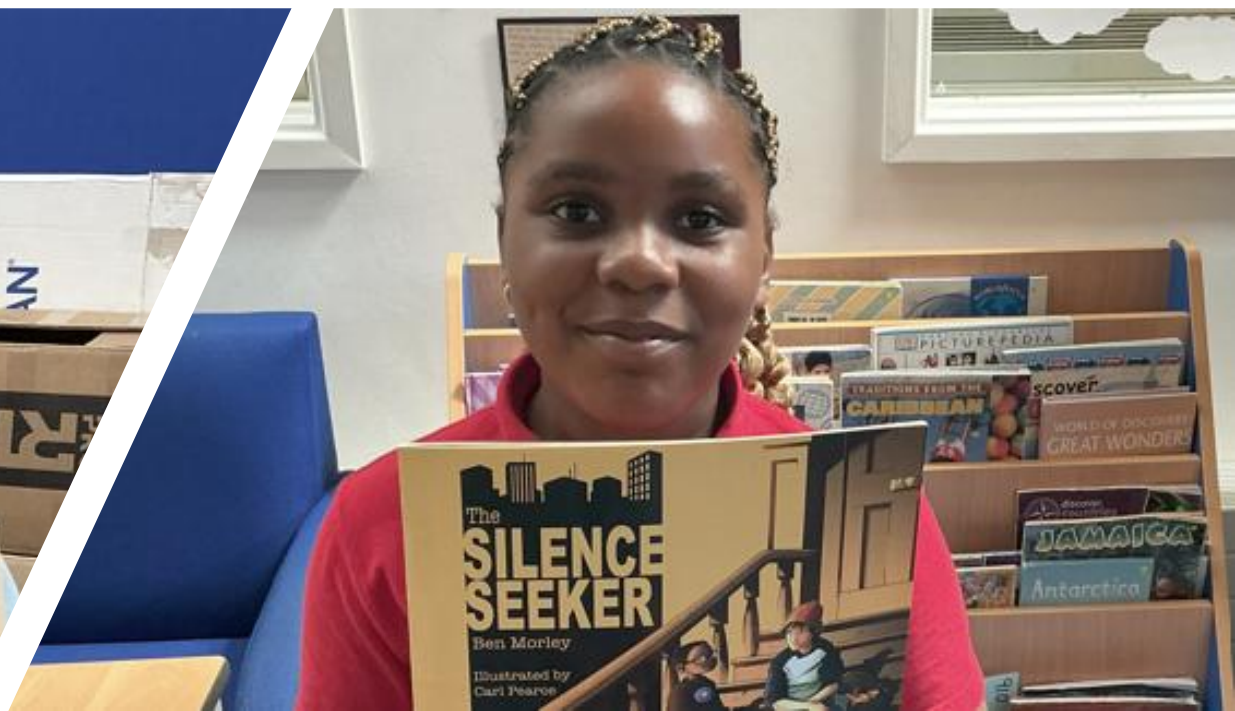




- There are many children's picture books that express the theme of **hope**, especially in the context of refugees.

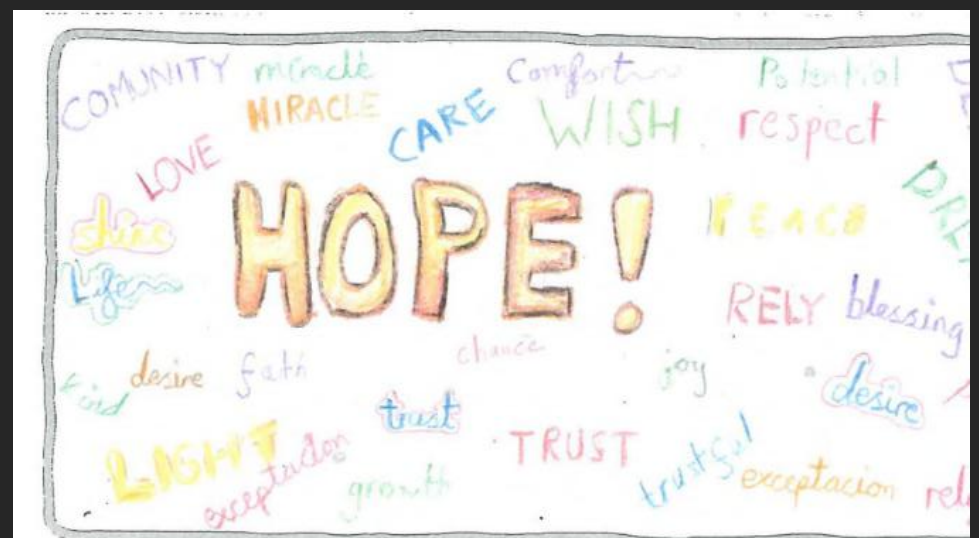
