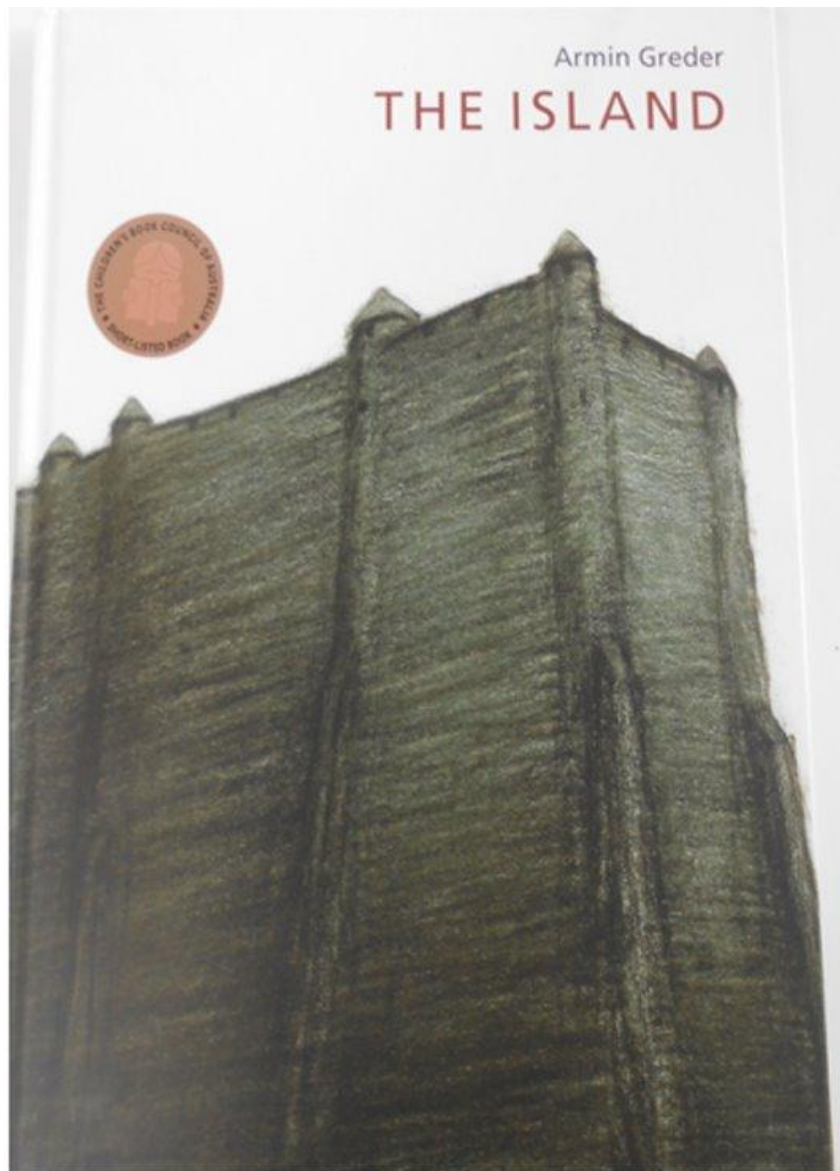
Trapped Populations:
